

GODDARD HIGH SCHOOL INSTRUMENTAL TRIP RULES

1. Students are subject to all state rules and regulations.
2. Students are subject to all Goddard High School rules and regulations.
3. Improper conduct in any way will not be tolerated.
4. **Students that do not report to the buses on time will be responsible for cab fare to meet up with the band. (An adult will travel in the cab with the student)**
5. **Violation of A, B, C, D E, F G or H will result in the students removal from this trip and sent home. Their parents and/or guardians will be responsible for paying for a one way ticket to Wichita, Kansas. There will be no adult traveling back with the student.**
 - A. **A student shall not possess, sell, use, transmit, distribute, or be under the influence of any narcotic drug, hallucinogenic drug, amphetamine, barbiturate, marijuana, any unprescribed controlled substance, drug look alike, drug paraphernalia, or alcoholic beverage of any kind during the trip.**
 - B. **A student shall not possess, handle or transmit any illegal substances, weapons or dangerous objects that can reasonably be considered as a weapon. They shall not possess, handle or transmit any other items that are not allowed on school grounds or property or at a school activity, function, or event.**
 - C. **A student shall not cause, attempt to cause, or verbally lead another to believe he may cause physical injury or bodily harm to another student, school employees, trip sponsors or volunteers.**
 - D. **No student will be allowed to get into any vehicle that is not associated with the Goddard Instrumental trip.**
 - E. **No student shall leave ANY trip activity (airports, hotel premises, bowl games, zoo, cruise, performance sites, practice sites, amusement parks, or eating sites) unless accompanied by a school administrator, teacher or trip sponsor.**
 - F. **No student shall to steal or shop lift.**
 - G. **No students will be allowed in a hotel room that contains males and females unless the hotel door is open up all the way.**
 - H. **No student will be allowed to leave their hotel room after curfew. Curfew will be set by Ms Weber.**

6. Students caught in a violation of I, J, K, L, M, N, O or P will receive disciplinary action, according to the rules and regulations of Goddard High School.

- I. A student shall not possess or use any form of tobacco.
- J. Improper display of public affection will not be permitted.
- K.. Improper use of language will not be permitted.
- L.. A student shall be dressed appropriately for all performances, rehearsals and activities.
- M. A student will not be allowed to leave the trip with relatives, friends, etc. This will be strictly enforced due to liability. Friends and relatives may make arrangements to visit students during some of their activities.
- N. A student will not be allowed to stay at the hotel or on a bus alone.
- O. A student will not be allowed to throw anything out hotel or bus windows.
- P. Students are responsible for keeping their plane area, bus area, and hotel rooms, clean and undamaged. **Students and or their parents and/or guardians will be responsible for paying for all incurred damages.**
