This event will also be incorporating the 75<sup>th</sup> anniversary and will serve as one of the requirements for the 75<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Award.

The Cub Scout patch, Cub Scout Family patch, Cub Scout Leader patch, and Cub Scout Pack patch. We will qualify for the Cub Scout Pack patch. This is the only year these will be available. Don't let it slip by.

We had 4 Bears and 1 Wolf transfer in to our Pack. Bruce has identified Dens that can accept the new scouts and will confirm with the Den Leaders.

**Action Item:** Please be sure to get your awards to Karin by August 15<sup>th</sup>. Make sure you include loop and pin awards for BB gun and Archery if your scout attended camp and completed the requirements.

We will have representatives at each of the schools during Open House Night on August 15. We will distribute flyers and have sign up sheets. We would like to encourage the scouts to wear their uniforms during the Open House.

Pack 775 and Pack 776 will work together on August 22 to form Dens and get the boys assigned to their new Leaders. We will break them out in groups to do different activities. We will need help from our Leaders to take the groups. There will be a change in the charges this year. The new scouts will pay \$20 for registration which will cover their membership through the end of February, 2006. With their membership, they will receive a 75<sup>th</sup> Anniversary pin, Derby kit, a case to display their car, rank book and cover, and Boys Life Magazine through February 2006. When their payment is made, they will receive a coupon for the above items. Our Pack can pick up the merchandise for the scouts. We will have scout shop items available at the August 22 meeting. This will include shirts, kerchiefs, etc.

September 15 is another recruitment opportunity at the schools for our Pack. It is a nationwide push for scouting recruitment. Dave D will be coordinating the public relations for the event.

In February, all scouts, including the new Tigers, will re-register for \$10. Boys Life will be available for \$12, Pack fee will be \$20 for a total of \$42 (\$30 without Boys Life).

The September Committee Meeting will be moved to the 9<sup>th</sup> of September due to the holiday weekend.

**Roundtable:**

Tiger Rama is set for October 1. We will invite our new Tigers. The hours are from 10 a.m. to noon at the Riverlawn Church. The cost is \$4 for Tigers and \$4 for their partners. There will be events for the Tigers including the Tiger Roundup and Tiger Walk. The events are set to "get to know other Tigers". They will also receive a patch for the event.

The District has requested that we host a Pinewood Derby for Tigers. There would be a \$5 fee. Our Pack would handle the concession and run the Derby. It would be an all day event. This is an opportunity for our Pack to earn enough money to get a new track. We are thinking about the October-November period.

**Pending Business:**

We will be receiving information at the next Committee Meeting concerning the Goddard Fall Festival and options available for our scouts to march in the parade. We will be pulling in the 75<sup>th</sup> Anniversary theme to continue our requirements for the Pack patch.
