### **Treasurer's Report: Dale**

This exhausts all the major expenditures for 2006. Remainder will be for summer activities.

### **Cubmaster's Report: Bruce**

Blue and Gold was a big success. St. Elizabeth Ann let us use their facility for free. We will be donating \$50 to their ministry.

Roundtable talked about the Outdoor Webelos Training. You can register on line or at the Scout Shop. Training will begin at 7 a.m. on Saturday and will end at noon on Sunday.

Sedgwick County Medical Services will be holding a program for helping kids to understand bullying. The program is No Bullies – No Victims. More information will be on our website.

We have received our Quality Unit Status for 2006. We should have our patches by May. Fred M stated that we exceeded the Friend of Scouting commitment. We were just under \$1,000. Our Pack received one of the highest amounts for contribution. Wednesday they will start calling everyone again for more donations.

The District will be beefing up recruitment in the Spring. Dave D informed us that one of the schools will allow us to come in on May 11. Last year White Buffalo District recruited 2,000 scouts in the Fall. They only except about 200 in the Spring.

We were in the Time Sentinel for our Bike Derby. Check out the March 30 edition.

The August Pack Meeting will be a picnic. It will be an opportunity to pass out some of the awards.

## **Past Business:**

### **Summer Camp:**

Outstanding fees are due at the April 24<sup>th</sup> Pack Meeting. It was recommended that leaders download the leaders guide from the website. Check the camp section. Forms are also on the website. Medication sheets need to go to the camp with the boys. Big Bear and Webelos Adventure needs a tour permit. The leaders are responsible for completing the tour permit. You need to turn in the permit three weeks prior to the event.

Day Camp within the area does not require a permit. There were some changes to the Day Camp. You should have received an e-mail with the changes.

The April 29 & 30 Fun with Son was cancelled.

It would be beneficial to bring the camp fees to the Dodge Ball event to give time for us to compile the data.

Pinewood Derby – there was a concern with a car running off the track. It could have been handled differently. Races ran quicker. The track is in Chuck's garage. He plans to build a carrying case.

Tammy will set up a table at the Dodge Ball event and will have packets for each Den.

As a follow up to a previous question concerning Senior Webelos. A suggestion was made to do the cross-over in January instead of February or March. They could still participate in the Blue and Gold and Pinewood Derby. They wouldn't have to pay the new Pack fees. This means the Arrow of Light would have to be completed 30 days early.

**Summer Programs:** We need three events planned to achieve the Summertime Activity Award. The boys need to participate in three events this summer. We plan five to allow more opportunities to meet the requirement. We just need 50% participation for the Pack award.

**Walk for Wildlife:** – June 9 & 10. Scouts set up Friday evening after supper. When they get up Saturday morning, they will be the first group to begin the walk. There is no expense for this.

**Space Rockets:** July 29 – 9 a.m. to noon. The Pack will purchase the rockets. We will meet at the community center to construct the rockets. We will go to an open field for the launch. We may invite the science teachers from the other schools. We are working with Dan F.
