We would like to encourage participation in the religious programs. The boys' workbooks as well as the leader/parent handbooks are available at the scout shop.

The Friends of Scouting campaign was extremely successful. The goal of \$500,000 was attained.

October 20-22 is the Webelo Works – This aids in the readiness needed for Boy Scouts. This is great for senior Webelos. \$8 per boy or adult. Information is on our web site.

Past Business:

Summer Camp:

Camp fees are paid for two leaders per Den. When a leader can not attend, transfer of the fee payment will be address on an as needed basis. We did pay for two adults to go in place of leaders.

Please review the web site for information concerning camp. Tents need a sign that clearly states “No Flame in Tent”. Attachments were sent to each Den concerning camping information. 88% of the boys are attending one of the camps.

Den 4 had a situation when Fun with Son was cancelled. Two of the boys were unable to find anything else to attend. There are three Wrangler overnight opportunities. An offer was made to fund the boys and their family for one of the overnight games.

Campership money uses: Discussion was on the possibility of other uses such as books or uniforms. It was decided that the popcorn money is for camp opportunities.

Thanks were expressed to Shawn and Jason for their help on the camp programs. We are close to breakeven with the estimated and actual funds.

Pack Scholarship:

There was discussion on the Pack scholarship fund. We currently have a balance of \$400. Whether or not to place a cap on the fund was reviewed. There will be information concerning the fund on the web site. The cap of \$1,000 was suggested. We will have a better idea what to expect once we complete the School Night for Scouting.

Pack T-Shirts:

Pack T-Shirts will be distributed at the May Pack meeting. We will have a table set up to hand out the shirts.

New Business: Bruce

Rockets – We plan to order 60 kits. We are estimating 40-45 boys. We prefer to make sure we get enough for each scout. Ordering 60 will make sure no one is left

out. The event is planned for the last Saturday of July. We will meet at the Community Center. It will take about 90 minutes to construct the rockets. Drinks will be provided. We expect to finish between noon and 1 p.m. All supplies will be provided. The price will include all materials.

Hutchinson Cosmosphere and Waterpark activity – Please make sure you have permission forms filled out for anyone attending. We reserved about 70 slots. We need to have a total number planning to attend. This should be separated into the number of cubs, number of adults, and number of siblings. Dens are responsible for the transportation. We will be applying for a local permit. We will need the year, make, and model of the vehicle that will be used. Driver's license number is also needed. We plan to have a patch for attendance at this event.

ACTION: Provide information including # of cubs, adults, and siblings. Year, make, and model of vehicle. Driver's license number of driver. Please bring this to the May Pack meeting. Permission forms (cubs only) need to be turned in at the June committee meeting. Bring sack lunch and spending money to the event.

May Pack Meeting will have an Indian theme Bruce and Chuck will be wearing Indian attire. Boys will receive a chip that marks their rank. They will throw the chip in the fire. We plan to put war paint on the boys. Don't forget their new neckerchiefs. We are looking for an MC for the evening. Set up will be at 6 p.m.
