Boy Scout Achievements – Handout shows the items that should be done with the family. Achievement number is also listed. Make sure you mark the handbook when you complete an achievement. When three achievements are completed, let us know so we can order his bead.

Meeting Activities – Handout shows what we have scheduled for the different meetings. They are not in any particular order and can be done at any meeting. The boys will each have an opportunity to serve as a Denner as least two months. When they serve as Denner, they assist in the planning of the meeting. The responsibilities are listed at the top of the page. Please choose two of the meeting activities and work with your scout to present these items when they are selected as Denner. You can sign up now for them or take it home and let me know. You want to let your selection be known before someone else chooses that activity.

Meeting Schedule – This has been a tough task as everyone has so many other activities that we need to work around. We are hoping that Wednesday will work out if we have it at 5:30. If you have another activity at 6:30, we are hoping that you can leave early enough to make it to the other meeting without missing too much of the boy scout meeting. We will try to complete all achievements before anyone has to leave so they will only miss closing activities. We have some suggested dates for field trips and ask that everyone checks their schedules to see if these dates work and whether they need to be morning, afternoon, or evening.

This is also something your son, as the Denner, should help to coordinate. He would also be asked to take pictures and write a small article for the scrapbook.
